Once again the Virginia Peninsula Car Club Council (VPCCC), Newport News Police Department (NNPD), Newport News Sheriff's Dept (NNSD) and the Newport News Parks, Recreation and Tourism Department (NNPR&T) are contacting organizations to partner with them by serving as a program event sponsor of the 6<sup>th</sup> Annual Virginia Fall Classic (VFC). The VFC is several Charity Events with a Car and Motorcycle Show at the center of it. All proceeds from the events will be donated to the Children's Hospital of The King's Daughters (CHKD) for their facility on the peninsula in Newport News, Virginia. The five year total donation to CHKD has been \$140,304.40 (03-07 events). Our best year's charity car show, the weather was with us, had nearly 500 vehicles and had over 5000 spectators & participants. Last year, despite the rain and having to delay the show till Sunday, we had nearly 300 cars, BUT we were able to donate **\$47,146.22**. We hope with your help this year, we are able surpass that!

This year's events will be held on October 24<sup>th</sup>, 25<sup>th</sup> & 26<sup>th</sup>, 2008 in the Newport News City Park and at Ferguson Enterprises Inc. The different events are open to the public with free admission for all spectators. (A small donation is requested for the car & show spectator parking held on 10/25). The car & bike show is open to all makes and models. They range from antique, classic, muscle, hot rods, and modern vehicles, motorcycles and special vehicles made with today's modern technology. Also, there will be displays of unique or special vehicles.

We are asking you to partner with us by serving as a program or event sponsor. Each business or organization's name will be posted in a conspicuous location during the event, on the website and will be included in the program announcements at the show on Saturday, October 25<sup>th</sup>.
